





BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- Must have Current DoD Contract or possess the “Potential” to obtain a DoD Contract in the future.
- Contract/Company must be registered with DTIC.
- Must possess a certified ‘need to know’.
- U.S. Citizen representing a U.S. owned company.
- Current personnel and facility clearance (for classified material requests).




MISSION

- Established because of the recognized benefit to the Navy of private industry participation in R&D relevant to Navy requirements.






- Help the Navy create and evolve its R&D plans by stimulating regular communications between Navy and Industry.

- Reduce the expense and time for Industry in gathering data on the Navy's R&D plans.




AVAILABLE DOCUMENTS (aka THE FREE STUFF)

- Directives/Briefings/Reports






