Amendment 0001

The purpose of this amendment is to replace the cost proposal spreadsheet and proposal checklists with updated versions, which are attached.

The following questions have been received and answers are provided:

1. Please provide assistance in locating the appropriate POC to make an initial inquiry to. The Science and Technology section and the Discovery and Invention links on the ONR web site do not appear to provide the name and email address of an appropriate POC.

Response: Go to the ONR website, www.onr.navy.mil and click on the Researcher tab to access links to all of the various technical areas. Alternatively, go to www.onr.navy.mil/02/baa/ and review the active and archived Broad Agency Announcements to find one that is related to the area of interest; contact the identified Program Officer.

2. Our team has a specific area it wishes to propose. What POC may be contacted?

Response: See the answer to the first question.

3. Does the 35% indirect cost restriction to basic research apply in FY2010?

Response: At this point in time, there is no indirect cost restriction; however, the FY2010 defense budget has not yet been passed.

4. The qualifications requirement requests a resume from the PI and other key personnel AND full curricula vitae for Principal Investigators and consultants. What is the difference between a resume and a CV, and do you want two different things for the PI?

Response: The curricula vitae are geared toward universities and nonprofit organizations. Resumes are geared toward commercial entities. ONR expects to receive one or the other for the Principal Investigator, other key personnel and consultants.
