

BAA 07-017
NET SENTRIC SURVEILLANCE
AMENDMENT 0001

The purpose of Amendment 0001 is to extend the closing date for submission of white papers to 4:00 pm 16 April 2007 and to clarify delivery of submissions as described below:

1. Under Section I General Information, revise Paragraph 5. to read:

“5. Response Date -

White Papers: **16 April 2007**
Full Proposals: 29 June 2007”

2. Under Section I General Information, revise Paragraph 7. *important notices regarding questions* (fifth bullet) to read:

- “ Questions regarding white papers must be submitted by 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time on Monday, 2 APR 2007. **Questions after this date and time may not be answered, however, the due date for submission of the white papers is extended to 16 April 2007.**”

3. Under Section I General Information, revise Paragraph 7. *important notes* to read:

“ Important Notes -*

*1: This is the Official address for ONR. Deliveries should not be made to this Suite number. For the submission of the white papers, oral presentation materials, and full proposals, please refer to **paragraph 6** entitled “Address for the Submission of White Papers, Oral Presentation Materials, and Full Proposals” under Section IV entitled “Application and Submission Information.”*

*2. **If the Offeror chooses to use the United States Postal Service (USPS), it needs to use the Official address. Offerors should be aware that they need to allow up to an extra five (5) business days because USPS mail is sent to a central location for special processing before it is delivered to ONR. Papers may also be delivered by commercial carriers who have access beyond the lobby of the building for delivery directly to the identified room.***

NOTE: WHITE PAPERS/FULL PROPOSALS SENT BY FAX, E-MAIL, OR HAND CARRIED WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

4. Under Section IV. Application and Submission Information, revised paragraph 1.(A) to read:

“(A) White Papers:

Submission: The due date for white papers is no later than 4:00 PM (Eastern Time) on **16 April 2007**. White papers received after the published due date will not be considered for funding in FY08. Each unclassified white paper should state that it is submitted in response to this BAA.”

5. Under Section IV. Application and Submission Information, revise paragraph 3 to read:

“3. Significant Dates and Times -
