“Expeditionary Intelligence Surveillance, Reconnaissance Science and Technology”

The purpose of Amendment 0001 is to respond to questions submitted in response to the BAA and also to extend the due date of proposals from August 28, 2015 to **September 1, 2015**.

1. **Question:** Page Count: Page 19 of the BAA (under grants) has a 30 page limit "The cover page, table of contents, resumes and current and pending project and proposal submissions information are excluded from the page limitations." Is 30 pages the limit for contract submissions? If not what is the page limit for the technical volume?

Answer: The technical volume submission for contracts is limited to thirty (30) pages.

2. **Question:** Is the separate Statement of Work included in the page count; are there a specific number of copies to submit?

Answer: The separate non-proprietary Statement of Work is not included in the page count. One copy of the full proposal will be sufficient.

3. **Question:** Will MS Excel and MS Word 2013 formats be accepted? The BAA references 2007.

Answer: Any proposed format need to be compatible with Microsoft Office.

4. **Question:** Verify that a hard copy submission is not required. The proposal will be uploaded to <https://onroutside.onr.navy.mil/aspprocessor/isr30b/> and emailed to Martin Kruger.

Answer: A hard copy submission is not required. Please follow the instructions for full proposals in Section IV, paragraph A of the BAA.

5. **Question:** Page 24 of the BAA has an estimated award date of March 25, 2016. If April 1, 2016 is a start date of the period of performance for a 36 month program, the effort would extend into FY 2019, which doesn't appear to be included in this BAA. Should vendors use the 36 month period of performance or change the effort to 30 months or keep it at 36 months and use an October 1, 2016 start date?

Answer: ONR’s core program funding continues year after year, so a 36 month period of performance starting on April 1, 2016 is acceptable. Please use the 36 month period of period of performance.
