

**Amendment #2 for BAA 07-005**  
**“Human Performance Training and Education Program”**  
**09 February 2007**

1. Are there any incumbent Contractors for this requirement? If so please provide their names as well as the contract numbers.

**A:** No. There are no incumbent Contractors for this specific requirement.

2. On page 16 of the solicitation, in the section entitled *Industry-Academia-Government Partnering*, it states that “Government partners may include naval systems commands, naval laboratories or centers, or fleet/force commands.” Will the BAA support a proposal that involves a teaming agreement between a small business and a non-Navy government laboratory?

**A:** Yes. As long as the proposal clearly describes/demonstrates the applicability and generalizability of the work to the domains described in the BAA (e.g., Distributed Operations), it would support a teaming agreement with a non-Navy government agency.
