Broad Agency Announcement 10-006

“Navigation and Timekeeping Technology”

The purpose of Amendment Number 0002 is to provide answers to questions received under BAA 10-006 entitled “Navigation and Timekeeping Technology” as follows:

Q#1: Was there a Proposer's Day or Industry Day for this BAA?
