

Amendment 0005

Solicitation Number: ONRBAA11-019

“Department of Defense Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) (previously referred to as Joint Service EOD)”

The purpose of Amendment **0005** is to amend the BAA to delete the requirement for hard copy and CD-ROM submissions.

1. BAA 11-019 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Section IV, paragraph 2(b), page 12: Delete the following paragraph in its entirety:

“Offerors should submit one (1) original plus three(3) hard copies of their Technical and Cost Proposal package, and one (1) electronic copy on CD-ROM. Offerors shall follow the Technical and Cost Proposal Template. The electronic Technical and Cost Proposal should be submitted in a secure, pdf compatible format, save for the electronic file for the Cost Proposal Spreadsheet which should be submitted in a Microsoft Excel 2007 compatible format. All attachments should be submitted in a secure, pdf compatible format. “

(b) Section IV, paragraph 2(b), page 12: Insert the following revised paragraph:

“Offerors **may** submit one (1) original plus three (3) hard copies of their Technical and Cost Proposal package, and one (1) electronic copy on CD-ROM. **In the event Offerors chose to provide the hard copies and CD-ROM,** Offerors shall follow the Technical and Cost Proposal Template. The electronic Technical and Cost Proposal should be submitted in a secure, pdf compatible format, save for the electronic file for the Cost Proposal Spreadsheet which should be submitted in a Microsoft Excel 2007 compatible format. All attachments should be submitted in a secure, pdf compatible format. “

(c) Section IV, Paragraph 6, page 20. Delete the following paragraph in its entirety:

“All Classified White papers and Full Proposals (Contracts) are to be submitted via CD. For Classified Proposal instructions, please refer to “Content and Format of White Papers/Full Proposals” under Section IV Application and Submission Information. (See Page 10) “

2. All other requirements, including dates and times for receipt of full proposals remain unchanged.
