Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) Number: N0001415RFO11
“National Security Science and Engineering Faculty Fellowship (NSSEFF)”
Date: 29 June 2015

The purpose of Amendment 0001 is to amend the FOA with responses to questions submitted prior to 28 June 2015. Questions received after that date and before the deadline for submissions of questions will be addressed in a subsequent amendment.

N0001415RFO11 is hereby amended as follows:

Question 1: I have a simple question concerning the following eligibility statement: Accredited U.S. institutions of higher education (universities) with doctoral degree-granting programs are eligible to apply.

Does the number of graduates matter? We do have a PhD granting program in Agriculture, with relatively small numbers of graduates annually.

Answer 1: This question is addressed under “Eligible Institutions” page 9 of the FOA:

The number of graduates does not matter. Per page 9, Eligible Institutions, “Accredited U.S. institutions of higher education (universities) with doctoral degree-granting programs are eligible to apply. DoD institutions are not eligible to apply.” Also per page 9, Eligible Individuals, “Outstanding faculty with tenure and full-time research staff with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to conduct the proposed research as the principal investigator (PI) are invited to submit an application.”
