Question 1: Please clarify whether the government is looking to award a contract to a single company that would manage the overall new OTA, similar to the C5, UTIC or NAMC etc. OTA, and then have members of the new OTA perform the R&D?

Response 1: The Office of Naval Research (ONR) does not intend to establish a consortium or similar arrangement to manage the DSI. ONR contemplates a single award to a responsible Applicant to conduct research into decision science, develop prototypes which promote the application of decision science methods and techniques, and perform the management and administrative functions necessary to operate the DSI.
