Special Notice for Multi-Function Communications and Electronic Warfare (EW) for
Counter Radio-Controlled Improvised Explosive Device (C-RCIED) Workshop

The Office of Naval Research (ONR) is planning to hold a classified SECRET workshop entitled Multi-Function Communications and Electronic Warfare (EW) for Counter Radio-Controlled Improvised Explosive Devices (C-RCIED), May 11th-13th, 2010 in the greater Washington, DC area. The workshop will focus on the application of multi-function communication and EW technologies toward C-RCIED operations.

All industry participants will be required to: 1) hold a GENSER SECRET clearance, 2) be experts in the implementation of multi-function communication and EW concepts, and 3) provide a technical presentation on their experiences with the application of multi-function communication and EW systems during the workshop. Due to limited space, industry representation will be limited to two technical experts per organization and one twenty-minute PowerPoint technical presentation per organization. An organization is defined by its physical address and/or CAGE code.
