I. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this announcement is to notify interested parties of an [Office of Naval Research \(ONR\) industry day on October 5, 2017](#), to inform industry about areas of research in support of the Theater ASW Commander Battle Management Tactical Decision Aid (TASWC BaM TDA).

II. TOPIC DESCRIPTION

ONR Code 32 is seeking new technologies to develop an advanced tactical decision aid for the Theatre Anti-Submarine Warfare Commander to automatically develop a plan for operations against a potential adversary, to assess the effectiveness of the plan, and to determine when the plan needs to be modified.

Interested Industry members with relevant experience are invited to attend. The meeting will be held in the BJECC/Fran Rothwell rooms on the 14th floor and will be classified SECRET/NOFORN.
