Special Program Announcement for 2020 Office of Naval Research
Research Opportunity:
Affordable Mobile ASW Surveillance System (AMASS)

This amendment provides clarification and additional details concerning the content of White Papers. To the extent there is a conflict between this amendment and the original announcement, this amendment controls.

1. All white papers must completely cover all aspects of the project: array, packaging, deployment, and testing.
2. If more than one concept exists, it is acceptable to provide separate White Papers.
3. White Papers may be classified up to SECRET. In that case, in lieu of email submission, follow the mailing instructions in the BAA for classified proposal submission. Classified proposals must be submitted electronically on a CD.
4. Teaming is allowed
5. In describing your solution under “Technical Concept”:
 - Be concise and clear. Provide enough detail so you can be judged, but not so much that page limit is exceeded.
 - Identify proprietary elements if any.
 - Identify major risks and propose how you will mitigate them.
 - Provide a high level plan (Work Breakdown Structure, schedule).
 - Include estimates for production and acceptance of deliverables and an analysis of final demonstration and production Work Breakdown Structure.
 - Address prior Experience in solving similar problems.
 - List key personnel (not only the PI) with resumes (not to exceed one page each) attached (does not count against page limit). It is expected these personnel will work from start to finish on the part of the effort they are assigned.
 - Pictures and illustrations do not count against the 5-page limit.
6. In providing your “Rough Order of Magnitude (ROM) cost estimate, the estimated budget should fit the ONR plan and budget.
7. The following are inapplicable to White Papers:
 - a. Future Naval Relevance
 - b. Operational Naval Concept
 - c. Operational Utility Assessment Plan
