1. In Section IV, entitled “Application and Submission Information,” under subsection 1, entitled “Application and Submission Process,” under subsection (A), entitled “White Papers”, is revised to read as follows:

“Evaluation/Notification: Initial Navy evaluations of the white papers will be issued via E-mail notification on or about **15 July 2004**. Detailed technical and cost proposals will be subsequently encouraged from those offerors whose proposed technologies have been identified through the above-referenced E-mail as being of "particular value" to the Navy. However, any such encouragement does not assure a subsequent award.

Submission of Full Proposal: Any offeror may submit a full proposal even if its white paper was not identified as being of "particular value". However, the Navy's initial evaluation of the white papers should give proposers some indication of whether a later full proposal would likely result in an award.”

2. In Section IV, entitled “Application and Submission Information,” under subsection 3, entitled “Significant Dates and Times,” revise the table entitled “Anticipated Schedule of Events” to read as follows:
