ONR Industry Day Notice Large Unmanned Undersea Vehicle (UUV) Science and Technology

Description: The Office of Naval Research (ONR) plans to conduct an Industry Day to present an upcoming Broad Agency Announcements (BAA) for Large Unmanned Undersea Vehicle (UUV) Science and Technology.

The purpose of the Industry Day is to discuss technology needed for Large UUVs operating with long endurance in the littorals. The Industry Day will focus on the discussion of Navy Large UUV energy challenges, autonomous operations in the littorals, endurance technologies, and other details related to the forthcoming BAA for this topic. General questions related to the pending BAA will be accepted during the meeting for consideration.

The Industry Day will be held at the Office of Naval Research headquarters, 875 North Randolph Street, Arlington, Virginia 22203-1995 on Thursday, 10 March 2011. Check-in will begin at 11:30 AM Eastern Standard Time and the meeting will begin at 1:00 PM Eastern Standard Time.
