

**Amendment 0001**  
**Special Notice 14-SN-0003**  
**Special Program Announcement for 2014 Office of Naval Research**  
**“Acute Care Cover for Severely Injured Limbs (ACCSIL)”**

The purpose of Amendment 0001 to 14-SN-0003 is to answer submitted questions. This amendment includes questions received prior to 1700 Eastern Time Tuesday, 17 December 2013.

Questions received after that time but before the Deadline for Submission of Questions will be answered via the next amendment. Per page 6 of the Special Notice, questions submitted after 1700 Eastern Time, 9 January 2014, might not be answered.

**1. Question:**

In ONR BAA Announcement # ONRBAA14-001, on page 24, it is stated, "NOTE: If page limits are not specified, then consult with your cognizant technical POC." Special Notice 14-SN-0003 did not specify page limits. Please advise as to the page limits for the Full Proposal in response to Special Notice 14-SN-0003.

**Answer:**

For contract submissions, use the provided Cost Proposal Spreadsheet, Technical Proposal Template (pdf) and Technical Content Template (word), found on the ONR website at <http://www.onr.navy.mil/Contracts-Grants/submit-proposal/contracts-proposal/cost-proposal.aspx>. The Cost Proposal is unlimited. The Required Technical Proposal is unlimited. Limit the Required Technical Content Template to 20 pages, Times New Roman, size 12 font, single spaced. Do not alter margins. Do not use appendices to work around page limits. Insert POA&M directly into document.

Grant applications must be submitted through Grants.gov, will all required documentation. Limit the Technical Proposal to 20 pages, Times New Roman, size 12 font, single spaced. Do not alter margins. Do not use appendices to work around page limits. Include a Program Objective, Actions & Milestones (POA&M) Gantt chart with your schedule and deliverable timeframe. Cost proposal is unlimited.

Overall, it is expected that offerors proposing to all potential funding opportunities presented in this SN (internal bioactive coating, conformal cover, and prime integrator) would have a longer proposal length than those proposing to less than all three of the areas of interest detailed in this SN. Brevity will be appreciated in all cases.

**2. Question:**

Were any White Papers on this topic received by ONR or other Navy agencies?

White Papers are not accepted, only Full Proposals. The due date for Full Proposals is 27 January 2014. Full Proposals received after that date will be considered as time and availability of funding permit.
